
The U.S. Immigration System

2015 Immigration Enforcement Actions

The U.S. Department of Homeland Security (DHS) Office of Immigration Statistics (OIS) reports on several immigration enforcement actions, including apprehensions, arrests, determinations of inadmissibility, removals, and returns of unauthorized immigrants. This graphic provides information for these categories for Fiscal Year 2015.

ALIEN APPREHENSIONS



337,117 (72.9%) aliens were apprehended by CBP USBP

Customs and Border Protection (CBP) U.S. Border Patrol (USBP) is responsible for securing approximately 7,000 miles of international land border with Canada and Mexico and 2,600 miles of coastal border of the United States.

117,983 (25.5%) aliens were apprehended by ICE ERO

Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Enforcement and Removal Operations (ERO) serves as the primary enforcement arm within ICE for the identification, apprehension, and removal of certain aliens from the United

7,288 (1.6%) aliens were apprehended by ICE HSI

Immigration and Customs Enforcement (ICE) Homeland Security Investigations (HSI) Directorate is responsible for disrupting and dismantling transnational criminal threats facing the United States.

INADMISSIBILITY DETERMINATIONS

253,509

aliens arriving at a port of entry were determined to be inadmissible by CBP Office of Field Operations (OFO).

Immigration 33.1%


